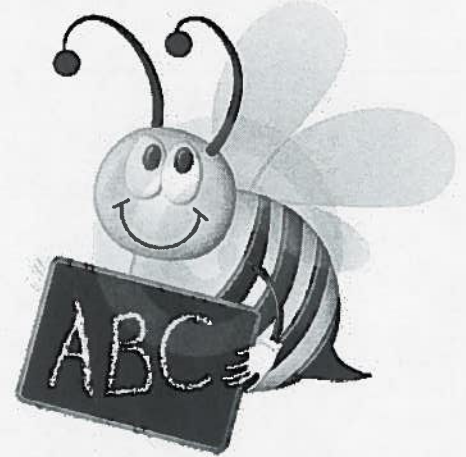
SPELLING BEE

The Annual Busby Spelling Bee will be held this year on January 12th at 11:30. We would love to have as many students as possible from Grades 3 to 6 participate.

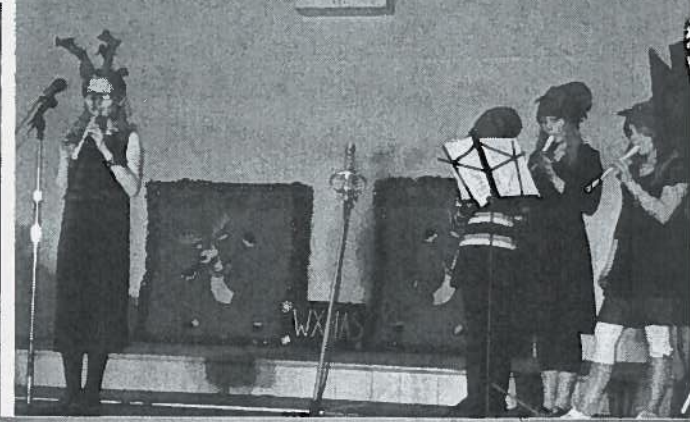
